- Port Master Plan Update. Master review continues.
- Port North Embarcadero. Review continues.
- **Port Summer shuttle**. Now running through Sept 4. \$3 per person. Route Harbor Drive Pedestrian Bridge to Sheraton Hotel Harbor Island with many stops between. Approx every 20 minutes.
- Manchester Pacific Gateway (NBComplex). Demolition continues. The Navy Building NW corner of Pacific Highway and G St will be built first, Navy move in, remainder of site demoed. Expect construction on the site to continue through 2020.
- **Council District Three**. Brian Elliot, <u>belliott@sandiego.gov</u>, is the new rep for Downtown replacing Roberto Alcantar.
- **Homeless.** Downtown has at least 859 Supportive Housing units and over 1400 shelter beds. The majority of all those in the City. Your Board believes that the areas outside of Downtown should share in the solutions to homeless issues by accepting additional housing. Action:

DCPC Officer Election. Subcommittee appointments. Children's Park, Marina, Front/ First/Island/Harbor. Discussed final schematic design. Removes Cedars on Front and First and replaces with street trees improving visibility into park. Removes some interior trees and installs more lighting. Adds concession building with restrooms and attendant. Adds children's play area in NW quadrant neat New Children's Museum. Adds adult fitness area at NE corner with fenced dog park between this area and concession building. Discussion of maintenance, security, restrooms, etc. Recommended Civic board and Park and Rec Board proceed to detailed construction drawing phase.
