Action:

13th/Broadway. EV North side of Broadway between 13/14th. Southern third of block, 18 story affordable housing with 273 units and some number undetermined of PSH units. 65 parking ug and 12 at grade. 7 of the at grade for FS Nr4. This was original place for FS Nr4, lot adjacent purchased and traded to city so station not on Bway. Under new rules this project would require zero parking. Recommended but do not eliminate any parking.

Union/Ash. LI North side of W. Ash, Union/Front. South half of block with 480 ft, 36 story tower with 395 units including 32 affordable. 272 required and 403 parking provided with 3 underground and and 4 above levels of parking. Only 30 percent of storage units provided. Recommended approval.

Jefferson. EV Makers Qtr, Full block Broadway/E// 15/16th. 8 story FAR 6.0 on site allowing 15.6, 368 units of which 19 affordable. 425 plus 66 tandem vs 376 req. Preserves historical facade on SW corner. Only 40% of storage units. Interior courtyard thru. Proposing Live/work units on Bway in lieu of active commercial. East and West stoops and bedroom windows problematic, low and next to sidewalk. Police prefer

low rise for helipad to the west. Recommended approval
